- > 3. Select Year 3 (Third Year)
- ➤ 4. Select Programme Type "Undergraduate" & Click on "Submit" button.
- > 5. Select Programme Name & click on "Apply" button.
- > 6. Fill all the fields & attached relevant documents, check the form & click the "Submit" button.
- > 7. Pay the processing Fees of Rs. 100/-. Take the "Payment Successful" screenshot for your reference.
- > 8. Take a printout of submitted application form and submit the same along-with photocopies of <u>all previous</u> semester mark-sheets (Sem. I to IV), 12th Mark-sheet, <u>Caste Category</u> (*if applicable*) at office counter No. 03 & 04 on 13th May 2024 to 18th May 2024 between 9.15 a.m. To 12.30 p.m.

• Instructions :-

- 1) All the fields are compulsory.
- 2) Those students, who want to take admission for the above mentioned TYBA subjects, must have that subject in FY/SYBA with no ATKT.
- 3) Students who seek admission at TY Classes should be eligible for the same i.e. they should not have ATKT either at FY or at SY level.
