• Procedure :-

- 2. Go to above mention web-site and scroll down and click "**Read all News, Notices & Updates**"
- 3. Click on the "Online Admission Application Form Link"
- 4. Select Year - 3 (Third Year)
- 5. Select Programme Type - "Undergraduate" & Click on "Submit" button.
- 6.. Select Programme Name & click on "Apply" button.
- 7. Fill all the fields & attached relevant documents, check the form & click the "Submit" button.
- 8. Pay the processing Fees of Rs. 100/-. Take the "Payment Successful" screenshot for your reference.
- 9. **Take a printout of submitted application form and submit the same** along-with photocopies of all previous semester mark-sheets (Sem. I to IV), 12th Mark-sheet, Caste Category (if applicable) at office counter No. 03 & 04 on 18th May 2024 to 25th May 2024 (Except Sunday & Bank Holiday) between 9.15 a.m. To 12.30 p.m.

• Instructions :-

- 1) All the fields are compulsory.
- 2) Those students, who want to take admission for the above mentioned TYBA subjects, must have that subject in FY/SYBA with no ATKT.
- 3) Students who seek admission at TY Classes should be eligible for the same i.e. they should not have ATKT either at FY or at SY level.
- 4) This form is generated only for the purpose of information and doesn't guarantee any claim to admission.
- 5) All admissions will be on provisional basis subject to document verification.
- 6) If any discrepancy found in the subject combination and documents, student will lose his / her Merit claim.
